European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology 5th EADV Spring Symposium

5th Spring Symposium of the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology (EADV), the framework organization on dermatological diseases negatively affecting not only the health but also the relations of individuals in social life, shall be organized for the first time in our country.

It is expected that around 3 thousand dermatologists from particularly Europe as well as from our country and all countries of the World will participate in the 5th EADV Spring Symposium to be held in Lütfi Kırdar Convention Center on May 22-25, 2008. Now that the 5th EADV Spring Symposium will be organized in Istanbul, an important step towards the dermatology congress held annually in Europe to be held in Turkey in the forthcoming years.

Our treatment modalities will be compared to the modalities in Europe

Prof. Dr. Mehmet Ali Gürer, Head of the Department of Dermatology in Gazi University Faculty of Medicine and the local chairperson of the 5th EADV Spring Symposium to be organized in Turkey, stated that gathering the dermatologists together, raising up the scientific level and organizing congresses towards this end are among the main functions of EADV and continued to add that "The main theme of the Spring Symposium will be "Dermatology Bridging the Continent". The treatment modalities in Europe will be compared to the modalities in Turkey in some of the sessions. We expect that the Congress will attract 3 thousand participants. There will be approximately 750 free papers, oral presentations and posters throughout the course of 3 days. 17 symposiums and 16 workshops will be held".

We commemorate the famous Turkish Dermatologist well known in the world of medicine

Prof. Dr. Mehmet Ali Gürer stated that "Prof. Dr. Hulusi Behçet, who presented Behçet's disease, a dermatological disease, to the literature, will be commemorated in the session devoted to this disease" and he emphasized that "the congress will prove to be useful in promotion of our country as well". He went on to add that "We will be hosting some congress participants coming to Turkey for the first time. I am sure that this congress will let them see Istanbul, get to know the individuals in Turkey and change their negative impressions if any. This is an important opportunity for the promotion of our country".

Prof. Gürer closed his remarks by saying: "I would like to welcome the European dermatology to our country and Istanbul once again and I would like to reiterate how strongly I believe that the participants of this congress will return to their homelands with major scientific contributions and pleasant memories and I hope to meet in Istanbul and Turkey in even greater organizations in the future once again."
